- 41 An original WWII Second World War era Royal Signals Officer's cap. Complete with cap badge to front and leather strapping. Rare.

- 74 A vintage early 20th century (possibly older) scratch built model of Admiral Nelson's Flagship HMS Victory . Well detailed, with detailed rigging and various deck elements. Possibly made by a prisoner of war. Uncased. Measures approx; 46cm tall.

- 98 A Cold War era Polish Akm rifle bayonet '06510' having a tan plastic grip hilt with rifle attaching guard, leather strap handle, traditional shaped blade, black scabbard and leather frog. Measures; 33cm overall.

- 99 An antique early 20th century pattern Edwardian soldier's mess dress uniform tunic. Red, with brass buttons fitted and shoulder straps. Named inside to a ' Nightingale '. No makers label present.

- 103 An antique 19th century Charles Boswell of London side-by-side double barrelled shotgun (butt only). Plate beautifully engraved and makers name to foliate engraving present.
